

Information Sheet for Hosting an ITPA Event

Host Facility will provide the following:

1. Transfer sled and all weights (can be contracted through ITPA)
2. Pull back tractors – minimum of three, need access two hours prior to pull
3. Grader, need access two hours prior to pull
4. Roller, need access two hours prior to pull
5. Working P.A. system
6. Dirt track – the track should be 30 – 35 feet wide and long enough for 300 feet of safe pulling area that allows for spotting and starting the sled.
7. Concession stand and restrooms
8. Announcer. (can be provided by ITPA for \$150 plus \$25 for local classes)
9. Allow 10 track officials (officers) in free
10. Allow 2 people per competing truck in free (can be asked to show membership card)
11. Lighting and grandstands
12. Water truck
13. Forklift or suitable equipment to lift 2,500 lbs. of weight for sled
14. Local advertising
15. People to collect and admit at gates
16. Pit area for competing vehicles
17. Local contact individual's name, phone number and directions to event location
18. Liability for any local classes
19. **Host facility receives revenue from gate fee and concessions. ITPA receives sanction fee from host facility and hook fee from all trucks competing in ITPA classes.**

Indiana Truck Pulling Association will provide the following:

1. Transfer sled and weights **if contracted for by host facility**
2. Track officials
3. Markers for dirt track
4. Insurance on spectator (\$5,000,000 liability) during sanctioned ITPA classes only
5. Pay awards to drivers
6. Scales for weighing trucks **if contracted for by host facility**
7. ITPA is not responsible for mechanical problems with the sled

The first class of ITPA trucks will start no later than 8:00 p.m. (EST). There will be nothing run between ITPA classes unless agreed upon at the time of contract signing.

ITPA reserves the right to discontinue the pull due to adverse track conditions

ITPA reserves the right to sell their shirts, hats, etc. at each event

ITPA reserves the right to promote their sponsors

In case of rainout please notify the ITPA president 6 hours prior to start of event. If the pull is underway, pay is prorated per class, UNLESS the ITPA event is 50% complete then full contract amount is due
